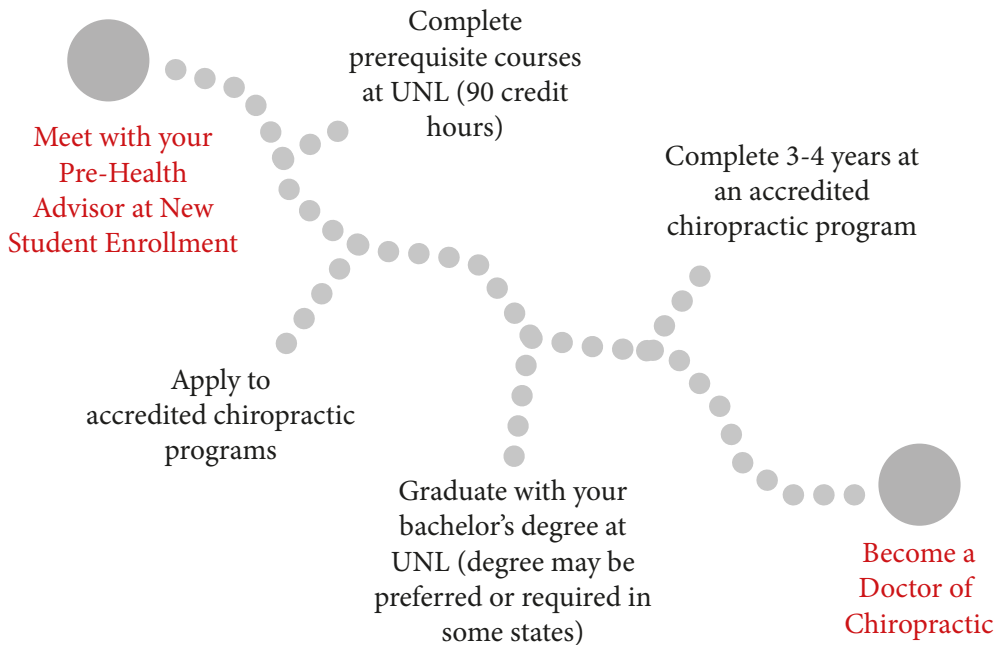


# N. Explore Center Pre-Chiropractic
