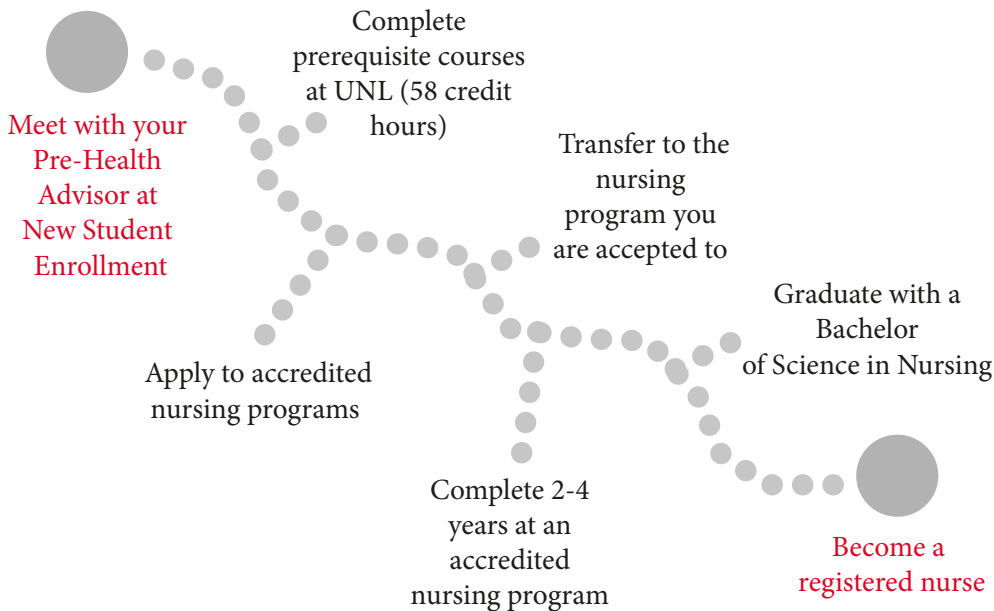

WHAT IS PRE-NURSING?

Nurses promote health, prevent disease, and help patients cope with illness. Nurses are hands-on healthcare professionals who provide focused and highly personalized care. The field has a wide range of career opportunities, ranging from entry-level to doctoral degrees. Pre-Nursing students have the option of completing prerequisites at UNL and then transferring to a traditional nursing program, or earning a bachelor's degree before pursuing an accelerated nursing program. Students work one to one with an advisor to reach their goals, and they do not need to choose a major while at Nebraska.

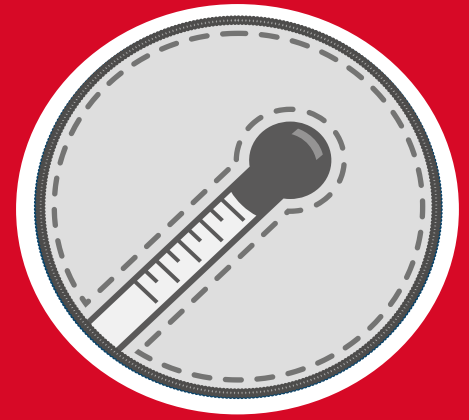

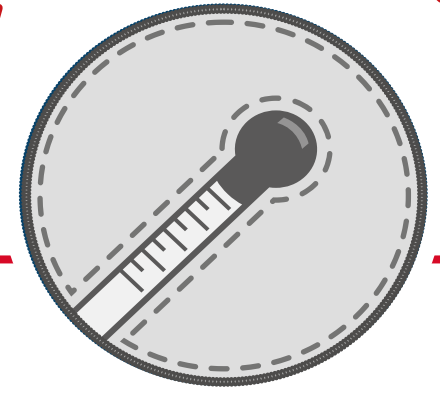
